

# UC Berkeley Summer Sessions Proctor Guidelines

*NUSCTX W104*

## Proctor Requirements:

- Available to administer the exam on **August 12, 2020 PT** (anytime that day)
- Available 2 hours to administer the exam
- Can monitor the student during the entire 2 hours, ensuring they are only taking the exam and not accessing other content in the course or via the Internet
- **Provide a computer with reliable internet access where the student can take the exam**

## Student Needs to Bring on the Day of the Final:

- Photo ID
- Mobile device (Only to be used for Two Step Authentication on Canvas prior to beginning exam)

## Student is NOT Allowed to During the Final:

- Books or notes
- Mobile devices or any kind of music players

## Instructions for Administering and Returning the Exam

- 1) Check the student's ID
- 2) Have the student log into Canvas
  - a. Have the student log into <http://bcourses.berkeley.edu>
  - b. Have student complete Two Factor Authentication with their mobile device
  - c. Once logged into Canvas have student put away mobile device prior to beginning exam
  - d. Verify they have logged into the correct user account. You can do this by viewing their name on the top right of the screen
  - e. Confirm identification with the student's ID
- 3) Administer the final exam to the student
  - a. Have the student enter the course – NUSCTX W104
  - b. Select "Quizzes" in the left navigational menu. You should be able to select "Final Exam." If the "Final Exam" is missing, email [summer\\_online\\_suport@berkeley.edu](mailto:summer_online_suport@berkeley.edu) or call (510)-664-9898
  - c. Click the button that says "Take the Quiz"
  - d. Input the access code you received from [summer\\_online\\_support@berkeley.edu](mailto:summer_online_support@berkeley.edu) to begin the exam
  - e. The student has two hours to complete the final exam
  - f. At the end of two hours, have the student submit the exam
- 4) Have the student log out of Canvas
