Proctor Requirements:

- Available to administer the exam after 2 p.m. PT on August 13, 2020 and completed before 1:59 p.m. on August 14, 2020 PT.
- Available 3 hours to administer the exam
- Can monitor the student during the entire 3 hours, ensuring they are only taking the exam and not accessing other content in the course or via the Internet
- Provide a computer with reliable internet access where the student can take the exam

Student Needs to Bring on the Day of the Final:

- Photo ID
- Mobile device (Only to be used for Two Step Authentication on Canvas prior to beginning exam)

Student is Allowed to Use During the Final:

- Two pages of notes, front and back
 - Four sides, typed or handwritten
- Calculator
 - Any scientific calculator is allowed, as long as it doesn't have wireless capability, and no ability to store notes

Student is NOT Allowed to Use During the Final:

- Books
- Mobile devices or any kind of music players

Instructions for Administering and Returning the Exam

- 1) Check the student's ID
- 2) Have the student log into Canvas
 - a. Have the student log into http://bcourses.berkeley.edu
 - b. Have student complete Two Factor Authentication with their mobile device
 - c. Once logged into Canvas have student put away mobile device prior to beginning exam
 - d. Verify they have logged into the correct user account. You can do this by viewing their name on the top right of the screen
 - e. Confirm identification with the student's ID
 - f. Student may use scratch paper while taking exam
- 3) Administer the final exam to the student
 - a. Have the student enter the course STAT W21

- b. Select "Quizzes" in the left navigational menu. You should be able to select "Final Exam." If the "Final Exam" is missing, email summer_online_suport@berkeley.edu or call (510)-664-9898
- c. Click the button that says "Take the Quiz"
- d. Input the access code you received from summer online support@berkeley.edu to begin the exam
- e. The student has three hours to complete the final exam
- f. At the end of three hours, have the student submit the exam
- g. Collect any scratch paper used and shred
- 4) Have the student log out of Canvas
